- Homoeopathic Doctor Faisal Saleem did not attend the meeting due to his personal engagements.

2. Meeting started at 10.30 a.m. Homoeopathic Doctor M.B. Jawed Awan recited verses from the "HOLY QURAN." Homoeopathic Doctor Siddique Ali Ansari offered Na'at Sharif. Meeting chaired by the President Homoeopathic Doctor Rao Ghulam Murtaza. He welcomed all the members for their participation in the meeting.

3. At the beginning of the meeting, the House offered Fateh Khwani for late mother of Homoeopathic Doctor Muhammad Asif Khan, Member NCH.

**Agenda Item No. 1: To confirm the Minutes of the previous 159<sup>th</sup> Annual (Budget)/Regular Meeting of NCH held on 3-4 June 2022.**

The Secretary put up first agenda item regarding confirmation of minutes of previous meeting held on 3-4 June 2022 and stated that as yet no objection against these minutes has been received from any member of the Council. At this juncture Homoeopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux

pointed out some spelling mistakes, which noted for correction. Thereafter, minutes were approved unanimously by the House.

**Agenda Item No. 2: To Confirm Minutes of Finance Committee Meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> September 2022.**

The Secretary presented minutes of the meeting of Finance Committee Meeting held on yesterday i.e. 12-09-2022. **He read out the same before the House, which were approved unanimously.**

**Agenda Item No. 3: To Confirm Minutes of Syllabus Committee Meeting held on 12<sup>th</sup> September 2022.**

The Secretary presented minutes of the meeting of Syllabus Committee held on yesterday i.e. 12-09-2022. The Chairman Syllabus Committee read out the same before the House. Homoeopathic Doctor Muhammad Tariq Khan questioned about the introduction of new course namely DHAP (Pharmacy). He stated that NCH has no mandate to start these types of courses related with other Council, which was clarified by Homoeopathic Doctor Ilhai Bux and suggested the new name “DHAP (Pharmacist)”. Homoeopathic Doctor Mahmood ul Haq Abbasi, Homoeopathic Doctor Aisha Nawaz, Homoeopathic Doctor Javed Akhter opposed the proposal of the Islamia University Bahawalpur regarding approval of 03 postgraduate Diploma courses. Homoeopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux stated that he has already e.mailed to the office of NCH on 24<sup>th</sup> June 2022 in this regard. He read out the contents of his e.mail and stated that the UAH Act 1965 read with its preamble, besides the principles of Homoeopathy, is not match-able to the program’s contents, especially the No. 2 & 3. The first one may help the manufacturing pharmaceuticals. The Council is unconcerned with any of the three diplomas in the present legal framework.

**Decision:**

**After discussion, the House approved the minutes of Syllabus Committee meeting dated 12<sup>th</sup> September 2022 with vote of dissent of Homoeopathic Doctor Mahmood ul Haq Abbasi, Homoeopathic Javed Akhter, Homoeopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux and Homoeopathic Doctor Aisha Nawaz.**

**2. The Chair further constituted a sub-committee comprising of Homoeopathic Doctor M.B. Jawed Awan, Homeopathic Doctor Saeed ur Rehman Khattak, Homoeopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux and Homoeopathic Doctor Jawed Akhter to look into matter of above 03 postgraduate Diploma courses as proposed by the Islamia University of Bahawalpur and following 2 Years three new diploma courses suggested by the Syllabus committee and their syllabuses:-**

- i) Homoeopathic Assistance Provider (DHAP)- Homoeopathic Dispensing**
- ii) Homoeopathic Assistance Provider (DHAP)- Homoeopathic Pharmacist**

iii) **Homoeopathic Assistance Provider (DHAP) – Homoeopathic Pharmaceutics.**

3. The chair further resolved to circulate proposed amendment in existing BHMS 5 years Degree Program, The Islamia University of Bahawalpur letter No. 967/UCCM dated 13-06-2022 alongwith its enclosures, proposed Draft Outline “The Homoeopathic Courses of Studies, 2020” alongwith Schedule I, II & III amongst members of the Council with request to submit their proposals (if any) within 15 days.

4. After finalization of syllabus of all courses by the committee will be forwarded to the Federal Government for Approval under Section 47 of the UAH Act II of 1965 under intimation to the University with direction that University cannot run these diplomas until approval of the Federal Government.

**Agenda Item No. 4: To Confirm Minutes of Time Scale Committee Meeting held 12<sup>th</sup> September 2022.**

The Secretary presented minutes of the meeting of Time Scale Committee Meeting held on yesterday i.e. 12-09-2022. The Chairman of the committee Homoeopathic Doctor M.B. Jawed Awan read out the same before the House, which were approved unanimously.

**Agenda Item No. 5: To discuss and approve Inspection Report of Abbott Homoeopathic Medical College Abbottabad.**

The chair present next agenda item before the House. The Secretary / Registrar informed the house that inspection of the college carried out on the request of the Principal in which he stated that the college administration has decided to switch over BHMS 5 Years Degree Program with Khyber Medical University Peshawar (KMU). He read out the inspection report of Abbott HMC Abbottabad dated 25<sup>th</sup> August 2022. The President pointed out that according to the instructions issued by the Ministry in case of Pakistan HMC Lahore separate building for DHMS and BHMS is required. He further referred the decision of the Council taken in its 158<sup>th</sup> Regular Meeting held at Karachi wherein the Council allowed the Homoeopathic Medical College to use their buildings for multiple disciplines. Homoeopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux stated that if there is sufficient space is available in the existing building then he can start BHMS Degree Program in the same premises.

**Decision:**

*The House approved the Inspection report dated 25<sup>th</sup> August 2022 and allowed BHMS 5 Years Degree Program in the same building.*

**Agenda Item No. 6: To discuss matter regarding vacation of NCH Karachi Building.**

The chair put up next agenda item and invited Homoeopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux to brief the house.

2. Homoeopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux briefed the House and read out report of the committee dated 24<sup>th</sup> September 2022. The points discussed, showing the half-grown intention representing the SMS are as follow:-

- a) The Tenant agrees to the rental rates as recommended by NCH.
- b) The Tenant desires that the rent be calculated based on measurement of the covered area excluding the open area of the building in use.
- c) The Tenant has not denied payment of all dues regarding perpetual rent increase of bygone tenancy duration and the period after termination of the contract.
- d) NCH insisted the Tenant for furnish the details of expenditure incurred on the construction in the backyard along with the purchase bills and payment vouchers so that the dues to the Council could be adjusted, making in acceptable to the official audit; and
- e) Homoeopathic Doctor Junaid Akhter Bukhari voiced the possibility of next meeting in the Council's office. The committee of the NCH did not decline the likelihood.

2. The Chairman Finance Committee said that in case of failure of Tenant i.e. Sindh Medical Store Karachi, the case will be referred to NAB.

3. Homoeopathic Doctor Siddique Ali Ansari said that first of all payable rent may be recovered from Sindh Medical Store then proceed for further agreement only for one year instead of 3 years. He proposed to issue show cause notice to Homoeopathic Doctor Junaid Akhter Bukhari on account of his involvement in this matter. He further stated that documents of the said building is available in KDA and CTC can be obtained on payment of fee to the concerned Department. He requested the House to authorize him for this purpose. **The House authorized Homoeopathic Doctor Siddique Ali Ansari to get CTC file of the building from the concerned Department and Council will pay the prescribed fee to him.**

4. Homoeopathic Doctor Mahmood ul Haq Abbasi recorded his vote of dissent for further agreement with SMS Karachi.

**DECISION:**

**The House approved the Report of the Committee dated 24<sup>th</sup> September 2022. On the request of Homoeopathic Doctor Siddique Ali Ansari, his name was included in the committee.**

**Agenda Item No. 7: To discuss Inquiry Report in case of Mr. Muhammad Hashim, show cause notice and its reply.**

The President put next agenda item and briefed the House. He stated that on receipt of complaint, Homoeopathic Doctor Saeed ur Rehman Khattak, Vice President was deputed as Inquiry Officer to inquire the matter. He submitted his report on 18-11-2021, with the following recommendations:-

- i) Homoeopathic Doctor Saad Abid Mir Ex-Principal Ashraf HMC Lahore was involved in illegal practice and found guilty.
- ii) He should be black listed to perform any in exams duty and furthermore stern action should be taken against him according to NCH Examinations Regulations, 1986.
- iii) He deceived NCH. As per statement of concerned persons and available records, he has been nominated and involved in corruption. So the registration should be cancelled immediately as Homoeopathic Doctor under Section 28 of UAH Act, 1965.
- iv) He involved in criminal offence; therefore, his case should be referred to FIA for legal criminal proceeding as the charge proved.

2. He further stated that on receipt of above inquiry report show cause notice was issued to Homoeopathic Doctor Saad Abid Mir on 25<sup>th</sup> November 2021 and his reply was received on 02-12-2021, which was examined and found unsatisfactory. **After discussion the House approved recommendations of the Inquiry Officer. The Council further approved cancellation of registration under Section 28 of the Act and resolved to refer his case to FIA accordingly.**

**Agenda Item No. 8: To discuss Inquiry Report in case of MS Aqleem Feroz, show cause notice and its reply.**

The Secretary/Registrar put up next agenda item and briefed the House about the complaint, inquiry report, show cause notices issued to Homoeopathic Doctor Saad Abid Mir and Homoeopathic Doctor Muhammad Umer by the office of NCH and their replies received which were examined and found unsatisfactory. He read out the recommendations of the Inquiry Officer before the House, **which were approved and resolved to cancel registration of both persons under Section 28 of the UAH Act 1965.**

**Agenda Item No. 9: To discuss M/o NHSR&C letter dated 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2022 regarding constitution of Selection Committee of NCH.**

The chair put up next agenda item before the house. The Secretary read out Ministry of NHSR&C letter No. F. 1-3/2017- AD (U/H) dated 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2022 therein the Ministry advised to NCH to constitute a Departmental Section Committee in the light of Sections 2 (b) and 14 (cc) of

UAH Act II of 1965. The House re-constituted the following Departmental Selection Committee of NCH:-

### **TABLE MOTION**

With permission of the chair, on a table motion, Homoeopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux stated that the Council's fund-generating sources facilitate restricted monetization as provided under Rules 13. The Council should be legitimated to recover monetary benefits closely associated with its administrative and financial functions, which have been ignored for a long. To fix this shortcoming, it is necessary to amend Rule 13 accordingly. An amendment be made by adding a new clause "ix" at the end of Rule 13, namely;

- (ix) **“All other sums, which may in any manner, become recoverable to or vested in the Council in respect of any matter incidental to the exercise of its functions and powers, including but not limited to the fees, penalties, fines, or other charges imposed under the Act and perpetual subordinate laws and orders.**

2. The Registrar Council is requested to initiate the process regarding this amendment.

### **Decision:**

The House approved the amendment in Rule 13 of UAH System of Medicine Rules 1980.

2. The House further approved the amendments in the Homoeopathic Examinations Regulations, 1986 except amendment in Regulation 2 (b). Homoeopathic Doctor Javed Akhter stated that Examination Regulation may be amended in the light of provisions of the Act.

### **TABLE MOTION**

With permission of the chair, on a table motion Homoeopathic Doctor Saeed ur Rehman Khattak, Vice President stated that on receipt of complaints of some Homoeopathic Doctors of Haripur he met on 15<sup>th</sup> August 2022 almost 30 Homoeopathic Doctors were present in the office of chamber of commerce and industry Haripur and discussed about the incident that had happened. They told that Additional Assistant Commissioner Revenue came on the advice of

Deputy Commissioner Haripur and checked the clinics. The team of the Additional Assistant Commissioner Revenue told the owners of the clinics that they should not possess empty bottles, globules, disketts and other homoeopathic vehicles and also warned them that they should not use the term “Doctor” with their names. On the basis of this, the team fined the Homoeopathic Doctors around Rs. 8 thousand to 15 thousand and also threatened the doctors that they will be jailed if they repeated this again under the Act 1962. After the detailed discussion we all decided that we should have a meeting with the Deputy Commission Haripur. On 16<sup>th</sup> August 2022 we met with the Deputy Commissioner at 10:30 am and submitted copy of UAH Act, 1965, A book of pharmacy which is according to our syllabus, that includes diskettes, globules etc and a copy of Homoeopathic Pharmacopoeia. After hearing everything, The Deputy Commissioner made a statement that there had been some contradiction between ordinance 1962 and UAH Act 1965. He told the DC that there is a huge difference between ordinance and Act. The Deputy Commissioner agreed with him and told that he would advice his staff that the Homoeopathic Doctors will have the freedom of practicing homoeopathy as per UAH Act, 1965. He suggested to think about the following:-

- a) To write a letter to all Secretaries of Provinces/ DG’s and all the other relevant departments about the freedom of Homoeopathic practice as per UAH Act 1965.
- b) To publish the important points of NCH recommendations as per UAH Act 1965. in the National Newspapers.
- c) To send a copy of the letter to the Homoeopathic Doctors of Haripur that filed a complaint on this matter.

### **DECISION:**

The House appreciated the efforts of the Vice President and advised the office to highlight the Public Circular/advertisement (viz. \_\_\_\_ ) as already available on the website of NCH for awareness of the public.
