INSTRUCTIONS RELATING TO MIGRATION
From one College to another College

1. This form is to be sent through the principal of the College where the student is enrolled, who will certify the correctness of the statements made by the student.
2. If the applicant is a detained student or one who has been degraded or against whom any disciplinary action has been taken, the principal should specifically mention this in his remarks.
3. The student should obtain the consent of the principal of the College he wishes to migrate to.
4. The leaving certificate is not to be given by a principal until transfer of a student has been allowed by the controller of Examinations, National Council for Homoeopathy. No admission without such approval shall be considered valid.
5. Attach the copy of Father's NIC, copies of Matric/F.A./F.Sc Certificates, promotion certificate etc. and transfer order or lease agreement in case of change of residence.
6. Every application for migration must be accompanied by the prescribed fee, which will not be refunded even if the application is rejected.
7. The application shall only be entertained where student to be migrated, If the college have vacant seat.
8. The application for Migration shall only be entertained before the announcement of the date of examination.
9. No students who have joined one program shall be admitted to another program in the same college or in another college.
10. The student has to obtain a leaving certificate. The certificate cannot be given by his principal until the migration has been allowed by the Controller of Examinations, National Council for Homoeopathy.
11. One or other of the following conditions if satisfied, namely:-
 - a. If a change of residence by his father or guardian has made it necessary for a student to change his College.
 - b. If the father or guardian of a student objects within three months to the admission of the student to that College.
 - c. If a candidate seeks migration owing to change in financial circumstances (such cases should be supported by certificate from this Principal);
 - d. If in the interest of College discipline, the Principals of the College concerned agree; and
