- Homocopathic Doctor Irum Naz Akhter and Homocopathic Doctor Aisha Nawaz did not attend the meeting due to their pre-engagements.
- 2. Meeting started at 11 00 a.m. Homoeopathic Doctor Tabass an Hussain recited verses from the "HOLY QURAN." Homoeopathic Doctor Siddique Ali Ansari offered Na'at Sharif. Meeting chaired by the President Homoeopathic Doctor Rao Ghulam Murtaza. He welcomed all the members for their participation in the meeting.

OFFICE POINTS

1ST DAY - (1ST SESSION)

Agenda Item No. 1: To discuss and approve the Revised Budget Estimates for the FY 2020-21 and Budget Estimates for the FY 2021-22

The Chair put-up the first agenda item before the House and requested Mr. Khalil Ahmad. Chairman Finance Committee, to present the Revised Budget Estimates for the FY 2020-21 and Budget Estimates for the FY 2021-22.

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2. Mr. Khalil Ahmad. Chairman Finance Committee, apprised the honorable members that the Annual Budget of NCH for the following Financial Years 2021-22 is required to be finalized before end of the current financial year 2020-21 in the light of Rule-9 of NCH Administration, Financial and Management Rules, 2008. As the current FY, 2020-21 will close on 30th June 2021. He further stated that the Budget Estimates were detailed discussed in the meeting of the Finance Committee yesterday. He read out head-wise Revised Estimates 2020-21 and Budget Estimates 2021-22 before the House. He also read out summary as under:-

- During the discussion, the head of Health Allowance, Homocopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux, questioned that in his view, Health Allowance is only payable to Health-related personnel who are working in Hospitals, i.e., Doctors, Nurses, etc. The Chairman clarified by stating that all persons serving in different Organizations / Departments/ Autonomous Bodies under the administrative control of the Ministry of National Health Services, Regulations, and Coordination are entitled to payment of Health Allowance.
- 4. Homoeopathic Dector Mahmood ul Abbasi referred to Rule 14 0f UAH System of Medicines Rules 1980 and requested restoration of Grant-in-Aid to Homoeopathic Medical Colleges from own resources of NCH. He also cited the earlier meeting of the committee held in the office of the Chairman Finance Committee for grant-in-aid out of NCH resources. He proposed, the amount lying in NBP may be transferred to FWB for gaining of high profit.
- 5. Homocopathic Javed Akhter stated that Assignment Account should also be included in the Budget summary. The Chairman Finance Committee showed severe concern due to the non-inclusion of the assignment account in the Budget Summary by the Account Branch. He further directed that in future assignment account must be included in the budget summary. Homocopathic Doctor Javed Akhter proposed that NCH has sufficient balance, therefore; it is necessary to purchase a plot for NCH in ICT surrounding NIH Islamabad like NCT and establish National level Homocopathic Hospital in Rawalpindi/Islamabad as well as in all four Provincial Headquarters. Homocopathic Doctor Waheed Ahmad suggested renovating/upgrading the present NCH office as early as possible. The House accepted their proposals and constituted a development committee comprising of Mr. Khalil Ahmad (Chairman Finance Committee), Homocopathic Doctor M.B. Jawed Awan, Homocopathic Doctor Javed



Akhter, Homoeopathic Doctor Muhammad Aslam Khan and Homoeopathic Doctor Muhammad Idrees Tareen.

- 6. The Chairman Finance Committee assured that in the future, he would try to allocate a separate sufficient budget from the Federal Government for NCH to nieet the requirements of the Council. The members of the Council appreciated the viewpoint of CFC.
- 7. Homoeopathic Doctor Faisal Saleem draw the attention of the nouse that huge payment is lying pending of TCS and LCS couriers on the part of NCH. So the house constituted a committee comprising of Chairman Finance Committee and Registrar who will look into the matter.

DECISION:

After discussion, the members finally agreed to the draft budget estimates for the next financial year 2021-22, as detailed above, and voted to pass the same unanimously.

1ST DAY - (2ND SESSION)

Agenda Item No. 2 (a): To confirm Minutes of the previous 156th Regular Meeting of NCH held on 11-13 August 2020

The Secretary / Registrar put up agenda item No. 2 (a) regarding confirmation of minutes of the previous meeting, which have already circulated amongst the members of the Council. He stated that two (02) members of the Council raised their objections to the minutes. With permission of the chair, he read out objections before the house as under:-

Agenda Item No. 2 (b): To confirm Minutes of Sub-Committee Meeting for an award of Grant-in-Aid to Homoeopathic Medical Colleges held on 17th November 2020.

The Secretary / Registrar put up the next agenda item and read out Minutes of the sub-committee meeting held on 17th November 2020 before the House and stated that these minutes have already been circulated amongst the member of the Council. The House confirmed these minutes unanimously.

Agenda Item No. 2 (c): To confirm Minutes of Syllabus Committee Meeting held on 8th April 2021.

The Secretary / Registrar put-up the next agenda item and stated that minutes have already been circulated amongst members of the Council with agenda letter.

Homoeopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux referred to Section 47 of the UAH Act 1965 and said 2. that before amendments in the DHMS Syllabus, previous approval in writing of the Federal Government is pre-requisite; therefore, this exercise is illegal. He further stated that a postmatriculation Four-Year Diploma (DHMS) is not to be associated with Under-graduates degrees are defined in concerned Education Policy 2020 of HEC. The changes in the syllabus of DHMS means changes in the Schedule IV annexed to Regulation 32 of the Homocopathic Examination Regulations 1986. It requires a statutory process. So far if the committee has already "approved" the changes, seeking views is unnecessary. It is noteworthy that committees are for suggesting directions or and recommendations. Modification or diversification of undergraduates and higher courses of studies are possible through National Curriculum Revision Committee (NCRC) to be constituted by HEC. A drift of the M-Phil course of study was tabled and approved instantly. It is noteworthy that the draft was never circulated or seen by the members of the committee. Reportedly, it was presented during or a few hours before the meeting by some members adjusted unofficially. An unavailable draft syllabus of MD in four disciplines was also stamped as approved.

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- 3. Homoeopathic Doctor Javed Akhter seconded Homoeopathic Doctor Hahi Bux and stated that he has also filed objections on the minutes.
- 4. Homoeopathic Doctor Mahmood ul Haq Abbasi, Homoeopathic Doctor M.B. Jawed Awan, and the Vice President took part in the discussion.

Decision: After detailed discussion and considering all aspects of the matter, the Chair resolved that:-

- a) Approved Minutes of Syllabus Committee meeting held on 8th April 2021, subject to replacement of the word "approved" with the word "recommended" against decision item No 1, 3 & 4.
- b) Copies of all recommended Syllabuses would be circulated amongst members of the Council. The members of the Council should submit their proposals, if any, within 15 days for consideration by the syllabus committee. After approval by the syllabus committee all syllabuses would be forwarded to the concerned quarters for approval.
- c) The issue of existing Members WhatsApp Group was discussed and declared unofficial. Communication amongst members of the Council through e-mail was approved. All members were requested to send their e-mail address to the office of NCH.

Agenda Item No. 2 (d): To confirm Minutes of Registration & Renewal Committee Meeting held on 8th April 2021.

The Secretary / Registrar put up the next agenda item and read out the committee meeting minutes. He stated that action has already been taken in decision (b) regarding printing the 1000 booklets of DHMS Syllabus and Code of Ethics.

2. Homoeopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux stated that revision of the Code of Ethics is the mandate of the Act, Rules and Regulation Committee, not Registration and Renewal Committee. Therefore the meeting of the said committee was out of scope. He referred the approved TORs of Act, Rules, and Regulations Committee whereby functions of the committee have defined. He cited that the existing booklet of Code of Ethics does not fulfill the requirements and needs new framing keeping because of existing changes. He also read out his objections forwarded to Registrar vide letter dated 11-03-2021 and 05-04-2021.

<u>Decision:</u> The House confirmed the minutes of the meeting dated 8th April 2021 with direction to the Registration, Renewal and Code of Ethics Committee to forward his proposals to the Act, Rules and Regulations Committee to consider the amendments and modifications in the Code of Ethics.

Agenda Item No. 2 (e): To confirm Minutes Inspection Committee Meeting held on 16th November 2020.

The Secretary / Registrar put up the next agenda item regarding confirmation minutes of the subject committee meeting held on 16th November 2021, approved by the House with a vote of dissent of Homocopathic Doctor Hahi Bux.

Agenda Item No. 2 (f): To confirm Minutes of the committee constituted for interviews of candidates for award of the title of professorship held on 17th November 2020.

The Secretary / Registrar presented the next item with information; these minutes have already been circulated amongst members of the Council. He further read the names of 45 homoeopathic doctors awarded different titles by the Council.

- 2. Homocopathic Dector M.B. Jawed Awan requested the house to relax the criteria regarding the award of the professorship title, particularly members of this august house. He further suggested awarding the title of professorship to all members of NCH on an honorary basis.
- 3. Homoeopathic Dector Muhammad Asif Khan, Homoeopathic Doctor Naeem Hafeez. Homoeopathic Doctor Laisal Saleem, Homoeopathic Tabassum Hussain disagreed with Homoeopathic Doctor M.B. Jawed Awan and suggested that title may be awarded on a merit basis only.
- 4. Homoeopathic Doctor Siddique Ali Ansari, Homoeopathic Doctor Faisal Saleem and Homoeopathic Doctor Naeem Hafeez supported. Homoeopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux for an award of the title of the professorship.
- 5. Mr. Khalil Ahmad, C.F.C., agreed with the criteria fixed by the Council and opposed granting titles to Diploma holders. He further stated that only academic staff is entitled to an award of such titles.
- 6. The Vice President seconded the viewpoint of the Chairman Finance Committee that the criteria are to be finalized with the consensus of the Council. He further stated that a reminder to be issued to Homoeopathic Doctor Mehmood Riaz Ahmad and Homoeopathic Doctor Muzahir Hussain Zaidi to provide requisite documents. He disagreed with the proposal to award title to members of the Council on an honorary basis.
- 7. Homoeopathic Doctor Siddique Ali Ansari opposed the proposal regarding the withdrawal of titles already awarded. Homoeopathic Doctor Mahmood ul Haq Abbasi seconded him and suggested that the criteria fixed by the Council be followed...
- 8. Homoeopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux showed his concerns on the constitution of the committee previously and stated that in the preceding meeting of the Council, the proposed criteria for the award of the title of professorship on the outline of PMDC. As far as his case is concerned, with 40 years of homoeopathic clinical practice, more than 16 years of teaching experience, and 62 years of age, he would value the reputation more than anything else, and the

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ridiculous attitude was enough to understand the determination. Now he is no more interested in title so far.

9. At this stage, the Vice President clarified his position and suggested constituting a new committee for interviews of candidates. All decision of the Council is being taken on a majority basis.

<u>Decision:</u> The Council confirmed the minutes of the interview committee meeting dated 17th November 2020. Accordingly the said criteria shall be circulated amongst all Homoeopathic Medical Colleges.

2. The House further reviewed and approved the following criteria for the award of different titles:-

- 5. The house restored application of Homoeopathic Doctor II.hi Bux received in the office.

Agenda Item No. 2 (g): To confirm Minutes of Act, Rules, and Regulation Committee meeting held on 5th September 2020.

The Secretary / Fegistrar put up the next agenda item before the House. Homoeopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux, Chairman, of the said committee briefed the House. The House, after discussion, confirmed the Minutes of Act, Rules, and Regulations Committee meeting held on 5th September 2020 except agenda item regarding "Revisiting the Yardstick."

2. The chair also briefed on the UAH Amendment Bill to enhance minimum qualifications for admission in DHMS, passed earlier by the Senate of Pakistan and referred to the National Assembly.

Agenda Item No. 2 (h): Minutes of Finance Committee Meeting held on 16th June 2021

The Secretary/ Registrar put up the next agenda item before the House regarding confirmation of minutes of the Finance Committee Meeting held on 16th June 2021. The Chair requested Chairman Finance Committee to present these Minutes before the House for approval. He read out the minutes of the meeting before the Council, which were unanimously approved / confirmed by the House.

2. Homoeopathic Doctor Javed Akhter thanked and appreciated the efforts taken by the Chair and CFC for the welfare of the staff of NCH. Homoeopathic Doctor Naeem Hafeez also appreciated the CFC on good briefing.

- Homoeopathic Doctor Irum Naz Akhter, Homoeopathic Doctor Aisha Nawaz and Homoeopathic Doctor Muhammad Tariq Khan did not attend the meeting due to their pre-engagements.
- 2. The meeting started at 11:00 a.m. under the chairmanship of Homoeopathic Doctor Rao Ghulam Murtaza. Homoeopathic Doctor M.B. Jawed Awan recited the verses from the "HOLY QURAN." Homoeopathic Doctor Siddique Ali Ansari offered Na'at Sharif. The House offered Fateha for the daughter-in-law of Homoeopathic Doctor M.B. Jawed Awan, Homoeopathic Doctor Khalid Masood Qureshi, Homoeopathic Doctor Waqar Anjum, and others.

Agenda Item No. 3: To discuss the request of Homoeopathic Doctor Sadaqat Ali Khan dated 16-12-2020 regarding restoration of his registration.

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The Secretary / Registrar put up the agenda point relating to Homoeopathic Doctor Sadaqat Ali Khan. He stated that the practitioner's registration was cancelled with the approval of the Council on account of his involvement in unethical advertisements in print and social media vide letter dated 20th November 2020. He filed an appeal for restoration of his registration on 16-12-2020. Later, he filed a WP No. 66866/2020 in Lahore High Court Lahore. After hearing all the necessary parties, the honorable court vide order dated 18-1-2021 directed NCH through a speaking order to decide the pending appeal of the petitioner according to the law within one month of receipt of the certified copy of the order. On receipt of the order with the application of the petitioner/applicant, called for a personal hearing on 18th January 2021 before the Chairman Registration, Renewal, and Code of Ethics Committee vide letter dated 6th January 2021. He attended the hearing, admitted mistakes, apologized, and assured that in the future, he would strictly follow the provisions of the UAH Act, 1965, Rules and Regulations framed there-under particularly Code of Ethics. He has submitted a court-stamped excuses affidavit on 25-01-2021.

<u>Decision:</u> The House accepted his appeal and restored Registration No. 69711 and Renewal Serial No. 8081 with effect from 17-06-2021.

Agenda Item No. 4: To discuss the request of Homoeopathic Doctor Muhammad Waqas Azam dated 02-12-2020 regarding restoration of registration.

The Secretary / Registrar briefed the house about the cancellation of registration of Mr. Muhammad Waqas Azam and read out his appeal dated 02-12-2020 regarding restoration of registration and renewal. Homoeopathic Doctor Faisal Saleem state I that he visited his clinic and noted that he is involved in using unauthorized titles and claiming specialist of different diseases. After discussion and assessment, the House rejected his appeal.

Agenda Item No. 5: To discuss the request of Homoeopathic Doctor Muhammad Ishaq, Farhan HMC Sargodha, dated 09-01-2021 regarding restoration of his registration.

The chair presented the next agenda point and directed Secretary to brief the house. The Secretary / Registrar stated that the registration and renewal certificates of Mr. Muhammad Ishaq were cancelled on 19th June 2021 on untoward behavior with Inspector during March Test 2019 with the approval of the Council. At this juncture, the chair read out his appeal wherein he

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accepted mistake and assured that he would be careful in the future. The President stated that he is a patient of kidney and under treatment in a hospital for dialysis. The House took the Ienient view in the case and resolved to restore his Registration No. 37375 and Renewal Serial No. 18227 w.e.f. 17-06-2021.

Agenda Item No. 6: To discuss the matter regarding the issuance of practicing experience certificates to Registered Practitioners of KP by NCH.

The Secretary / Registrar put next point before the house. The Chair invited Homocopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux to narrate his viewpoint.

- 2. Homocopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux stated that he had addressed 02 letters to the President and Registrar of the Council on 17-09-2021 and 04-03-2021 to clarify the issuance of experience certificates to the practitioners of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. Still, neither was replied by the Council nor anyone in Member's WhatsApp group. The question arose when some homoeopathic practitioners acknowledged that favor and support in obtaining the practicing experience certificate on Facebook, However, it was a certification without criterion by the NCH office. It is out of the possibility to certify that such person is practicing the homocopathy for three or more years as required by the KP Public Service Commission for the position of 04 Homocopathic Doctors in BPS-16. Reportedly, the Council adopted a method to issue the said certificates for the blessing of the teaching institutions following illogical, supposititious, and not more than testifying the eyeless circumstance. It is noteworthy that NCH is the only regulatory body for homoeopathy and people either rendering the services as a member or as regular employees are bound to think a hundred times when attempting an unusual task. However, the matter was resolve-able judicially and prudently without impairing the rights of applicants / candidates for the above-referred positions announced by KP-PSC. The Registrar issued rare types of experience certificates to the practitioners so a comprehensive clarification is required.
- 2. The Registrar clarified his position and stated that experience certificates issued earlier to homocopathic doctors of KP on 14th September 2020, addressed to the Superintendent KPPSC with the consent of the then President NCH Homocopathic Doctor Mahmood ul Haq Abbasi, were rejected by the KPLSC. Thereafter, a new experience certificate template was composed with the deliberation of Vice President Homocopathic Doctor Saced ur Rehman Khattak based on experience certificates duly signed by the Principal of H.M. Colleges. Moreover, these experience certificates have been issued to 125 practitioners of KP free of cost.
- 3. Homoeopathic Dector Ilahi Bux stated that job of Homoeopathic Doctors are self-employed. Therefore, issuing the experience certificate, the office was required to obtain the documents including the last three-year Income Tax Returns as professional services, at least the previous three-year challan receipts of professional tax, at least the previous three-years tenancy agreement along with payments receipts of rent of the premises acquired for the clinical purpose, at least three yearly payment receipts of signboard fee, or any other document evident to the certificate applied for.
- 4. Homoeopathic Doctor Saeed ur Rehmat Khattak stated that after the rejection of the experience certificates by KPPSC, he met with the Chairman KPPSC and requested to resolve

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the issue amicably. As a result, revised certificates were issued to facilitate the Homocopathic Doctors of KP for appointments against four posts

- 5. Homoeopathic Doctor Mahmood ul Haq Abbasi suggested preparing a policy for issuing of experience certificates and authorized only the Principal of H.M. Colleges for the purpose.
- 6. Homoeopathic Doctor Javed Akhter and Homoeopathic Doctor Muhammad Asif Khan proposed that the fee must be fixed as a verification fee of documents.
- 7. Homoeopathic Doctor Muhammad Irfan Wali stated that experience certificates be issued as per previous practice
- 8. Homoeopathic Doctor Naeem Hafeez said that SSC must be zerified before issuance of experience certificate to any practitioner.

<u>Decision:</u> The Chair resolved that criteria adopted earlier by the Council are correct because the KPPSC has accepted experience certificates.

Agenda Item No. 7: To discuss letter dated 11-02-2021 of Homocopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux regarding self-privileged communiqué with Provincial Chief Executive.

The Secretary / Registrar put up the next agenda item before the house. The chair invited the mover - Homoeopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux to offer his view. Homoeopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux referred his letter dated 11-02-2021 addressed to the President whereby the newly elected Vice President asked the Chief Minister, Kyber Pakhtunkhwa for meeting in connection with an unapproved and inadmissible self-created agenda. The Vice President requested to the Chief Minister for establishment of a separate council, while Homoeopathic Doctor Saced ur Rehman Khattak never been authorized to be called on with CM-KP. This bid of by-passing the Council office falls under exceeded or abused of powers in the light of Section 13 (2) of the Act. He requested the Vice President for clarification.

2. The Vice President Homoeopathic Doctor Seed ur Rehman Khattak explained his position and regretted from the House on the matter. He stated that he wrote a letter to the Chief Minister in the profession's best interest and highlighted some points, i.e., grant of loan for construction of H.M. college buildings. He assured the House that next time he would be careful in direct correspondence to higher authorities

Decision:

The House decided that all correspondence with the higher authorities should be routed through proper channels, i.e., National Council for Homocopathy.

Agenda Item No. 8: To discuss a letter dated 14-01-2021 of Homocopathic Doctor Hahi Bux regarding an un-sequenced List of NCH members..

The chair presented the next agenda point and invited Homoec pathic Doctor Bahi Bux to narrate his viewpoint.

2. Homoeopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux stated that he observed that logical order is not taken into account when compiling the list of the NCH members. He suggested a logical sequence of

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listing of members NCH for all-purpose including communiqués, minutes, website, etc. as follows:-

- a) Names of NCH Members in statutory order.
- b) Names of NCH Members in Alphabetical order
- c) Names of NCH Members according to their date of Birth.
- 3. Homoeopathic Doctor M.B. Jawed Awan proposed that list of NCH Members should be compiled according to their date of birth.

<u>Decision:</u> After discussion, the House decided that list of NCH members be compiled based on the date of registration with NCH as Homoeopathic Medical Practitioner.

Agenda Item No. 9: To discuss a letter dated 16-11-2020 of Homoeopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux regarding unethical and codal violation by a renowned practitioner.

The President took-up the next agenda point and invited Homoeopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux to brief the house.

- 2. Homocopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux stated that it is part of professional etiquette and ethics, especially in the medical profession. Therefore, a practitioner may avoid advertising (either himself or by any other person or agency) with glossy contents and appearance, canvassing, tall claims about treatment of specific diseases. It is a known fact that advertising lowers the dignity of the profession and othics or traps patients based on un-justifying claims rather than competence. Moreover, it becomes more vulnerable when an authoritative and influential one has committed it. He presented social media images appeared in different groups of WhatsApp and Facebook from Homocopathic Doctor Mahmood ul Haq Abbasi, Homocopathic Doctor Muhammad Asif Khan, Homocopathic Doctor M.J. Akbar, Homocopathic Doctor Zafar Hameed Malik, Homocopathic Doctor Iftikhar Haider, Homocopathic Doctor Zurriat, Homocopathic Doctor Muhammad Hani Mughal, Homocopathic Doctor Muhammad Iqbal. It is noteworthy that such ads fall under misconduct and are clear violations of Code of Ethics and Section 33 (4) of the UAH Act, 1965.
- The President said that we might decide to take action against the defaulters or to change the Code of Ethics.
- 4. Homocopathic Doctor Javed Akhter stated that existing Code of Ethics is obsolete and requested not to ignore an I take action against the council members.
- 5. The Vice President said that we should take action under the existing law against the defaulters who violate the provisions of Code of Ethics / UAH Act and complaints have been received in the office.
- 6. Homocopathic Dector IIahi Bux suggested preparing a formula in this regard and requested not to take action against the members of this august house.



- 7. Homoeopathic Doctor M.B. Jawed Awan stated that code of etnics is not obsolete; it is in order and proposed to refer A.R.R. Committee for revision.
- 8. Homoeopathic Doctor Muhammad Aslam Khan, Homoeopath c Doctor Waheed Ahmad, Homoeopathic Doctor Siddique Ali Ansari, Homoeopathic Doctor Nacem Hafeez, Homoeopathic Doctor Faisal Saleem suggested initiating legal action according to the provisions of Code of Ethics and UAH Act, 1965. In addition, homoecpathic Doctor Muhammad Aslam Khan proposed an advertisement in the newspaper for public at d practitioners awareness.
- 9. The chair asked both members of the Council to give their viewpoint.
- 10. Homoeopathic Doctor Mahmood uf Haq Abbas said that the said objection was received from Homoeopathic Doctor Hahi Bux when he was President of the Council and marked for Council's agenda. He presented an example of Form-& awarded by DRAP and assured will accept the decision of the Council.
- 11. Homoeopathic Doctor Mahmood ul Haq Abbasi and Homoeopathic Doctor Muhammad Asif Khan accepted their lapses and assured the house that they would not repeat and to be careful in the future. They agreed to submit an undertaking in this regard on court-stamped paper.

DECISION:

The Council resolved that:-

- i) A committee comprising Homoeopathic Doctor Hahi Bux and Homoeopathic Doctor M.B. Jawed Awan constituted for the drafting of the advertisement to be published in the newspaper.
- ii) A copy of the Code of Ethics be provided to the practitioners on payment of the fee at the time of registration / renewal.
- iii) Revision of existing Code of Ethics referred to A.R.R. Committee.
- iv) A committee comprising Chairman Registration. Renewal and Code of Ethics Committee, Homocopathic Doctor Muhammad Irfan Wali and Registrar to initiate action against the offenders.
- v) Excuses of Homocopathic Doctor Mahmood ul Haq Abbasi and Homocopathic Doctor Muhammad Asif Khan were accepted on their admittance of violations of Code of Ethics and assurance to be careful in future.

Agenda Item No. 10: To discuss letter dated 04-01-2021 received from Principal Pakistan Central HMC Karachi regarding restoration of allocated seats of both institutions in the light of Sindh High Court Orders passed in W.P. No. D-8197 of 2019.

Secretary / Registrar read out a letter dated 04-01-2021 of Secretary Pakistan Central Homoeopathic Medical College Karachi and NCH reply dated 6th January 2021. The President

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read out Order dated 08- 2-2020 of Sindh High Court Karachi passed in CP No. D-8197 of 2019. He also informed the background of the case regarding enrolment of students of Pakistan Central HMC Karachi. The requested the House to make a policy for the future regarding allocating of seats to H.M. Colleges.

- 2. Homocopathic Doctor IIahi Bux stated that Council is required to make a policy for all Homocopathic Medical Colleges, not for a particular college, and also develop suitable criteria.
- 3. Homoeopathic Doctor M.B. Jawed Awan suggested constituting an impartial committee evaluating all Homoeopathic Medical Colleges and re-allocating their seats.
- 4. Secretary/Registrar suggested withdrawing NCH letter dated 17-04-2019 and re-assess during Annual Inspection of H.M. Colleges.
- 5. Homocopathic Doctor Nacem Hafeez disagreed with the Registrar's viewpoint.
- 6. Homoeopathic Doctor Waheed Ahmad suggested reducing seats at H.M. Colleges. Homoeopathic Doctor Fa sal Seleem seconded him but proposed that enrolment of Pakistan Central HMC Karachi students in the name of NCH instead of college concerned.
- 7. Homocopathic Dector Muhammad Irfan Wali suggested deciding after thorough examination of the matter in all respects.
- 8. Homocopathic Doctor Muhammad Moin Khan and Homocopathic Doctor Siddique Ali Ansari both suggested accommodating the students of Pakistan Central H.M. Colleges only to secure students who have already been enrolled during the session 2019-20 by the Management of Pakistan Central HMC Karachi. He disagreed with the restoration of the previous quota of seats of both H.M. Colleges (Boys & Girls). He requested the House to resolve the issue amicably in the interest of students.
- 9. Homocopathic Dector Mahmood ul Haq Abbasi stated that observing students' punctuality might be resolved the issue.
- 10. Homoeopathic Doctor Javed Akhter defended the earlier decision of the Council in which seats of all H.M. Colleges were re-allocated as 60 to all H.M. Colleges.
- 11. The President, at the juncture read out decision of the Council taken in its 152nd Regular Meeting in which the conditions were imposed for enhancement of allocated seats beyond 60 and suggested an amendment in clause "c) as under:-

"For": In case of failure of the institution, 2nd inspection will be

conducted on payment of Rs. 50,000/-.

"Read": In case of failure of the institution, 2nd inspection be

conducted with all expenses of Homocopathic Medical College.

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DECISION:

The House accepted the above proposal unanimously and further decided that the previous decision of the Council regarding the restriction of 60 scats per annum remains intact. Although, these exceeding number of students were admitted in violation of instructions issued by NCH vide letter dated 17-04-2019. However, as a particular case the Council granted one-time permission to the exceeding enrolled students of Pakistan Central HMC Karachi to appear in the forthcoming DHMS Annual Examinations 2021 subject to fulfilling the requirements accordingly. However, in the future, enhancement in admissions will be entertained after an inspection under Regulation for Recognition of Homoeopathic Teaching Institutions, 1988 and criteria fixed by the Council.

Agenda Item No. 11: To discuss question paper and approve the results of MBBS Doctors held on 29th January 2021 under Section 24 (2) of UAH Act, 1965.

The Secretary / Registrar put up the next agenda point and informed the House that 12 applications were received in the office of NCH from MBBS Doctors for registration under Section 24 (2) of the Act. The earlier date for the test was fixed on 30th March 2020 but postponed due to Covid 19 and rescheduled on 19-01-2021. He read out Section 24 (2) of the Act, criteria framed by the Registration & Renewal Committee and approved by the Council in the past. He also presented Result Sheet of the test of MBBS Doctors held on 19-01-2021 as under:-

a)	Total candidates called for test	- 12
b)	Total candidates appeared	09
c)	Nos candidates declared Passed	08
d)	Nos candidates declared Failed	- 01

2. Homoeopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux pointed out that the question paper prepared for the test of MBBS Doctors was sub-standard and with huge mistakes as he has already encircled. Who is responsible, for which the image of NCH and homoeopathic profession is spoiled. He presented a copy of image of Facebook of Dr. M. Rehan Uppal (one of the candidates), who was involved in unethical advertisements. Homoeopathic Doctor Faisal Saleem suggested that Registration Certificates may be given to MBBS Doctors through official ecremony for promotion of homoeopathy. He further proposed that medals shall also be awarded to position holders of DHMS and BHMS.

Decision:

The chair accepted negligence in preparing the question paper, and for the future task for preparing of TORs of Testing process was assigned to Homocopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux. The House further approved the result sheet dated 19th January 2021 of MBBS Doctors (given below) with the direction to provide a copy of the Code of Ethics to every MBBS Doctor with Registration Certificate:-

A. The House further decided that Registration Certificates would be awarded to MBBS Doctors in the office of NCH after arranging a ceremony and in future medals shall also awarded to position holders of BHMS & DHMS in a convocation.

Agenda Item No. 12:To discuss and approve samples of Registration, Renewal, Diploma, Marks Sheets, four years DHMS Transcripts & Enrolment Card which will be printed from NSPC (Pvt.) Ltd Karachi in the light of letter dated 26th January 2021 including outer File Cover.

The Secretary / Registrar put up the next agenda item and read out Ministry of NHSR & letter dated 18th December 2020 regarding printing all security documents from National Security Printing Company (NSPC) instead of Pakistan Security Printing Corporation (PSPC). On receipt of instruction from the Ministry, we contacted Mr. Aamir Nadeem. Senior Manager NSPC Karachi submitted specimens of security documents required for printing vide letter dated 5th January 2021. The NSPC vide letter dated 26th January 2021 sent 06 number of print of under-mentioned documents for consideration and selection of one of each:-

- i) Certificate of Registration
 ii) Diploma Certificate
 iii) Renewal Certificate of Registration
 iv) Marks Sheet of all four years
 vi) Enrolment Card
 vi) Transcript of all four years
 vii) File cover with jacket.
- 2. During the meeting, the members took turns to view these templates and expressed their viewpoints

<u>Decision</u>: After a detailed discussion, the House authorized the President, Homoeopathic Doctor Hahi Bux, and Pegistrar to choose / select the distinct specimen of each document and place an order for printing to NSPC Karachi accordingly. File Cover with jacket for registration and renewal certificates will be printed locally.

Agenda Item No. 13: To discuss First Rent Appeal No. 109 of 2020 of NCH Karachi Building.

The chair put up the next agenda item and directed Secretary / Registrar to brief the House.

2. The Secretary / Registrar informed the House that the District Judge, Karachi East dismissed our First Rent Appeal No. 109/2020 on 08-05-2021 on technical grounds. He further stated that two (02) cheques worth a total of Rs. 3,300,000/- have been collected from the Court of Sr. Civil Judge & Rent Controller Karachi East on rent of NCH Karachi building and deposited into NCH Account No. 4105907080 (NBP) vide Receipt No. 53882 and 53883, both dated 14-06-2021. He further informed that a letter has already been written to the Ministry of NHR&C for consulting the Ministry of Housing & Works to assess the rent of Karachi's NCH building. Finally he requested the house to make a strategy for vacating of building from Sindh Medical Stores Karachi.

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- 2. Homoeopathic Doctor Siddique Ali Ansari and Homoeopathic Doctor Muhammad Moin Khan stressed re-opening of the Regional office at the Karachi building.
- 3. After discussion, the house constituted the following two committees comprising of the Council's members:
 - a) For negotiation with M/S Sindh Medical Stores Karachi for vacating of building:
 - i) Homocopathic Doctor Hahi Bux
 - ii) Homocopathic Doctor Muhammad Aslam KLan
 - iii) Homoeopathic Doctor Muhammad Asif Khan
 - iv) Homocopathic Doctor Muhammad Moin Khan
 - v) Homocopathic Doctor Siddique Ali Ansari
 - b) For restoration and up-gradation of NCH Regional Office Karachi
 - i) Mr. Khalil-Ahmad, CFC
 - ii) Homocopathic Doctor Muhammad Asif Khan
 - iii) Homoeopathic Doctor Siddique Ali Ansari
 - iv) Registrar, NCH
- 4. The above committees will submit their report in the next meeting of the Council.

Agenda Item No. 14: To discuss request dated 17-11-2020 of Principal Mianwali HMC Mianwali (Proposed) regarding the refund of the initial recognition fee of Rs. 50,000/-

On the next agenda point, the Secretary / Registrar informed the House that Homoeopathic Doctor Muhammad Rafi, Principal Mianwali HMC Mianwali (Proposed), requested vide his application 05-10-2020, 19-10-2020, and 17-11-2020 to refund the initial recognition fee of Rs. 75,000/- as he has no more interest in recognizing his college and decided to close the project. He further informed that the Principal Mianwali HMC Mianwali first time deposited a sum of Rs. 25,000/- on 04-10-2016 vide NCH Receipt No. 6831 against inspection was carried out through NCH inspectors on 8th January 2019 and deficiencies—conveyed accordingly vide letter dated 24th June 2019. A sum of Rs. 50,000/- vide NCH Receipt No. 42318 dated 28-10-2019 was deposited/received for re-inspecting the college. The council constituted an inspection team for re-inspecting but couldn't be accomplished to date.

Decision:

The House accepted the request of Homocopathic Doctor Muhammad Rafi, Principal Mianwali HMC Mianwali, and decided to refund the fee of Rs. 50,000/- asdeposited second time.

Agenda Item No. 15: To discuss the Inspection Report of Jinnah University for Women Karachi for BHMS Classes.

The Secretary / Registrar put up the next agenda item and requested honorable members to amend the name of the University as Jinnah University for Women Karachi instead of the University of Karachi. The Chair asked Mr. Khalil Ahmad, CFC, who inspected the university,

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to read the report before the House. He read out the report's contents and stated the Department of Homocopathy is established as per the requirement of Yard-Stick. The House, after some discussion, approved the report and recommended for recognition of BHMS classes.

Agenda Item No. 16: To discuss Inspection Report of newly established Shifa HMC Swat.

The Secretary / Registrar presented the Inspection Report of newly established Shifa HMC Swat, carried out by Homoeopathic Doctor Saeed ur Rehman Khattak and Homoeopathic Doctor Muhammad Irfan Wali, members of NCH. The House approved the inspection report subject to completion of the condition of Rule 9 (4) of UAH System of Medicines Rules, 1980.

Agenda Item No. 17: To constitute the Inspection Team to inspect newly applied Pir Mumtaz HMC Dera Ismail Khan.

The Secretary / Registrar informed the House that a application for recognition of Pir Mumtaz HMC Dera Ismail Khan with a prescribed fee of Rs. 50,000/- and requested for constitution of an inspection team. The house constituted an inspection team comprising Homoeopathic Doctor M.B. Jawed Awan and Homoeopathic Doctor Raheel Muhammad, Members of NCH.

Agenda Item No. 18: To discuss Audit Para relating to Murree HMC Islamabad regarding non-realization of change of building fee of Rs. 50,000/- for NOC.

The Secretary / Registrar put up the next agenda item and informed the House that Audit and Inspection of NCH Accounts for the FY 2017-18 to 2019-20 conducted by the Directorate General of Audit Federal Government during April 2021. During the audit, the Audit Authorities raised Audit Para relating to Murree HMC Islamabad. He read out the contents before the House, as under:-

"Rule 9 (6) of UAH System of Medicines Rules, 1980 states that no recognized institution shall change its building, where recognized, without prior approval of the Council and shall deposit Fifty Five Thousand rupees in favour of the Council as building change fee.

- Murre Homocopathic Medical College on 18-05-2015 reported a fee deposit of Rupees fifty thousand for change of building for which NCH issued acknowledgment vide receipt No. 115120 dated 18-05-2015.
- 3 Audit team observed that the receipt was not deposited with the bank as no evidence was available or provided.
- 4 Audit team is of the view that non-realization of fees in the bank is misappropriation. Accordingly, the audit recommends that responsibility may be fixed."
- 2. The Chair informed the House that Homocopathic Doctor Mahmood ul Haq Abbasi, President NCH, on behalf of Principal of Murree HMC Islamabad, deposited Rs. 50,000/through crossed cheque No. 5896558 (MCB), on account of change of building fee on 18th May 2015, office issued Receipt No. 115120 against the above cheque but not deposited in bank for clearance till July 2018. During the tenure of Administrator and after change of issuance date

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from 18-05-2015 to 18-05-2018, the cheque was deposited in NBP for clearance on 2nd July 2018 which was received back on 5th July 2018with the remarks "Listrument is Mutilated.". Unfortunately, the cheque remained in the office for 03 years. In this connection, a letter was sent to the Principal Murree HMC Islamabad on 06-07-2018, but after a lapse of 06 years, the matter is still stands at the same position. He invited Homocopathic Doctor Mahmood ul Haq Abbasi to say in his defense.

- 3. Homoeopathic Doctor Mahmood ul Haq Abbasi said that he was President of the Society when submitting the cheque. However, while depositing the same, he was not bearer of office of the Council; that's why he is unaware of the letter issued by NCH to the Principal.
- 4. The Chair responded that, unfortunately, the Management of Murree HMC Islamabad availed the NOC. Still, as yet fee has not been deposited in NCH Account as required vide decision of the Council taken in its 136th Meeting held in September 2012 and now under Rule 9 (6) of UAH System of Medicines Rules, 1980.

Decision:

The House resolved that:-

- N.O.C. issued vide letter dated 12th June 2015 and NCH Receipt No. 115120 shall stand cancelled due to non-depositing of change of building fee as required vide decision of the Council taken in its 136th Meeting held in September 2012 and now under Rule 9 (6) of UAH System of Medicines Rules, 1980.
- b) Shifting of College from 2015 to-date declared illegal.
- c) The Management should apply for NOC as afresh in accordance with Rule 9 (6) of UAH System of Medicines Rules, 1980 and UAH Act II of 1965.
- d) Only DHMS Annual Examinations 2021 will be conducted in same premises in students' interest to secure their future.
- e) A committee comprising of Homocopathic Doctor Nacem Hafeez and Faisal Saleem was constituted to examine the whole record and will submit report accordingly.

Agenda Item No. 19: To discuss the up-gradation of a post of Steno-typist MS Noor Fatima in the light of the Ministry's letter dated 18-12-2018.

The Secretary / Registrar put up the next agenda points and stated that the post of Stenotypist up-graded by the Federal Government vide Office Memoraneum No. F. 19 (55)/Legal-II/2010-1055 dated 23rd December 2011 from BPS 12 to BPS-14 with an enhancement of qualification for initial appointment from Matriculation to Intermediate. M/S Noor Fatima is working against the post of Steno-typist in BPS-12 w.e.f. 07-10-2016, she fulfills the criteria of enhancement for upgrading in BPS-14 following the pattern adopted for other ministerial staff of NCH. After discussion the House adopted above referred O.M. and granted approval of up-gradation of the post of Steno-typist from BPS-12 to BPS-14 w.e.f. 07-10-2016.

- Homocopathic Doctor Saeed ur Rehman Khattak, Homocopathic Doctor Irum Naz Akhter, Homocopathic Doctor Aisha Nawaz and Homocopathic Doctor Muhammad Irfan Wali did not attend the meeting due to their pre-engagements.
- 2. The meeting started at 11:30 a.m under the chairmanship of Homocopathic Doctor Rao Ghulam Murtaza. Homocopathic Doctor Waheed Ahmad recited the verses from the "HOLY QURAN" and Homocopathic Doctor Siddique Ali Ansari offered Na'at Sharif.

3RD DAY - SUPPLEMENTARY AGENDA POINTS

<u>Agenda Item No. 1: To discuss letter dated 25-05-2021 received from the Principal Shah Abdul Latif Bhitai HMC Karachi.</u>

The chair informed that the Council, in its 156th Regular Meeting, held on 11-13 August 2020, recommended Shal Abdul Latif Bhitai HMC Karachi for de-recognition under Section 19 of the UAH Act, II of 1965 but could not be forwarded to the Federal Government due to reshuffling of management. Meanwhile, a letter dated 25-05-2021 was received whereby the college Principal revealed that they had rectified the deficiencies. Therefore, the college is ready for re-inspection and begged for withdrawal of show cause notice.



Decision:

The House decided for re-inspect the Shah Abdul Latif Bhitai HMC Karachi and constituted an inspection team comprising Homocopathic Doctor Muhammad Idrees Tareen and Homocopathic Doctor Siddique Ali Ansari, Member of NCH.

Agenda No. 2: To discuss a matter relating to Nishtar HMC Chiniot and Dr. Noor HMC Multan as referred by the Examining Body NCH

1) Nishtar HMC Chiniot

The Registrar / Secretary put up the next agenda item and stated that the Examining Body discussed Nishtar HMC Chiniot based on the surprise visit report of DHMS Annual Examinations 2020 dated 9th October 2020 submitted by Homoeopathic Doctor Faisal Saleem, Member NCH. He further readout decision of the Discipline Committee of Examining Body, after an exhaustive discussion, resolved and decided to black-list the Nishtar HMC Chiniot as an Examination Centre and paper marking center, and Principal of Nishtar HMC is black-listed for three years. Furthermore, the report of Homoeopathic Doctor Faisal Saleem is forwarded to the Council in the light of recommendations No. 3 and 7 for further action, which is reproduced as under:-

Recommendations

- (1). Show cause notice be served to Homoeopathic Doctor Ashraf Zia Principal and Homoeopathic Doctor Ghias ur Rehman Vice Principal to cancel Homoeopathic Registration (RHMP).
- (2) Action admissible under rules should be taken against Homoeopathic Doctor Ashraf Zia and Homoeopathic Doctor Ghias ur Rehman, etc. They are engaged in criminal offenses. Many students grieved, and their future was spoiled, only having the interest of making money illegally. This matter should be forwarded/refer to Federal Investigation Agency (FIA) for legal criminal proceedings, punishment, and deceiving elements as the charges proved. They entertained students without roll no slips, playing with student's future, illegally and misuse of controller stamp, issuing fake and fictitious self-generated examination slips to the students is intolerable crime negligence and recovery of needful government official stamp.
- Homoeopathic Doctor Faisal Saleem also briefed the house.
- 3. Homoeopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux stated that charges might be framed and issue show-cause notices. Homoeopathic Doctor Javed Akhter seconded him.
- 4. Homoeopathic Doctor M.B. Jawed Awan said that both Principal and Vice-Principal registration might be suspended and issued show-cause notices.
- 5. Mr. Khalid Ahmad questioned about law provision and said that this is a clear-cut FIA case. Therefore, the council is required to withdraw recognition of this fake institution immediately.

DECISION:

The House resolved to issue show cause notice under Section 19 of UAH Act 1965 directing for submitting his reply within 15 days.

2) Dr. Noor HMC Multan

The Secretary / Registrar informed the House that the Examining Body had referred another matter regarding the building of Dr. Noor HMC Multan to the Council. He stated that a superintendent, namely Homoeopathic Doctor Foorq Langah, was appointed as center superintendent in the examination center of Dr. Noor HMC Multan in DHMS Annual Examination 2020. He addressed many complaints to the President. Registrar, and Controller of Examinations regarding the substandard building of the college. Meanwhile, earlier on 08-10-2020, an annual inspection of the college was carried out by the members of the Council, and in this regard copy of the inspection report was forwarded vide letter dated 11th September 2020 for information and removal of deficiencies within 30 days. He also read out inspection reports before the House. On receipt of a complaint from the center superintendent, a reminder was issued on 11th November 2020. The Principal of the College vide letter dated 01-06-2021 informed that all pointed out deficiencies have been removed. He provided a copy of the Map of the building and society renewal certificate dated 03-02-2020. At this juncture, Homoeopathic Doctor M.B. Jawed Awan added that the last time when he visited the college found in bad condition.

Decision:

The House constituted inspection team comprising of Homocopathic Doctor Muhammad Tariq Khan, and Mr. Khalil Ahmad, CFC for inspection of the college.

Agenda Item No. 3: To discuss Surprise Visit Report of Jinnah HMC Karachi

The Chair informed the House that a complaint against Jinnah HMC Karachi was received from Dr. Muhammad Rizwan Siddiqui, which was read out before the House. He stated that on receipt of the complaint Homoeopathic Doctor Muhammad Aslam Khan, Member NCH, was deputed to visit the college and look into the matter.

- 2. Homocopathic Poctor Muhammad Aslam Khan stated that he visited and noted that Jinahh HMC Karachi is closed for the last six months and not working properly. There was no record of Managing Society and accounts etc. was available. One person namely Mr. Waqar Ahmad stated that now he is new owner of the building and running Jinnah HMC Karachi.
- 3. Homocopathic Dector Siddique Ali Ansari stated that students of Jinahh HMC Karachi visited his college and complained that there is no "studying" in the college. He also talked the students with the Controller of Examinations on the issue. A few days back, he saw a signboard "college is open" in front of the college.

4. Homoeopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux proposed that the examination center of Jinnah HMC Karachi be cancelled, Principal and Complainant be called for a personal hearing.

Decision:

The House decided to call the Principal Jinnah HMC Karachi along with Mr. Waqar Ashraf for a personal hearing in the office of NCH Rawalpindi. Meanwhile, examination forms in respect of students of Jinnah HMC Karachi may be entertained from any other local college of Karachi City. The Examination Centre for forthcoming DHMS Annual Exam. 2021 shall also be established locally till the final status of the Jinnah HMC Karachi.

Agenda Item No. 4: To discuss complaint dated 23-04-2021 against Sughra HMC Karachi with surprise visit report of Homocopathic Doctor Muhammad Idrees Tarcen.

The Secretary/Registrar informed the house that a complaint regarding permanent closure was received on Prime Minister's Performance Unit (PMDU) on 03-05-2021 from a citizen against Sughra Memorial HMC Karachi. On receipt of the complaint, the President NCH vide letter dated 20th May 2021 deputed Homoeopathic Doctor Muhammad, Idrees Tareen for a surprise visit to the college. He visited on 25-05-2021. The chair requested the concerned member who's visited the college to read out his report.

2. Homoeopathic Doctor Muhammad Idrees Tareen that Sughra Memorial HMC Karachi does not fulfill the requirements of prescribed Yard Stick. In present circumstances, the standard of education is not up to the mark. He recommended serving a show-cause notice to the college to remove deficiencies. In case of failure, the college is recommended for de-recognition under Section 19 of the UAH Act 1965.

Decision:

The House approved the surprise visit report dated 25-05-2021 and decided to show cause notice under Section 19 of the UAH Act 1965 to Sughra HMC Karachi.

MEMBER'S POINTS

Homoeopathic Doctor Faisal Saleem: To discuss Rule 12 (c) (ii) Existing rates of fees and remunerations be increased (a) 10% after every two years.

Homoeopathic Doctor Faisal Saleem stated that Rule 12 (C) (ii) is unjustified and suggested deleting the same from UAH System of Medicines Rules, 1980. After discussion the House constituted a committee comprising of Homoeopathic M.B. Jawed Awan and Homoeopathic Doctor Faisal Saleem who will propose draft amendments in UAH System of Medicines Rules, 1980.

To consider and discuss a letter of Homoeopathic Dr. Khalid Mahanood dated 08-08-2019 regarding Centro-therapy.

Homoeopathic Doctor M.B. Jawed Awan stated that Homoeopathic Doctor Khalid Mahmood Shadab Homoeopathic Clinic Lahore requested to consider treatment of patients

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through Centro-therapy Accordingly, the House constituted a committee comprising Homocopathic Doctor M.B. Jawed Awan and Homocopathic Doctor Ilahi Bux to look into the matter after a personal hearing of the applicant.

CONCLUSION:

At 2: 00 pm, the meeting ended with a vote of thanks by the chair. At this moment, Homocopathic Doctor Javed Akhter suggested that the next meeting of the Council may be scheduled in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, if convenient.
